- Acknowledge the uniqueness of institutional profiles and self-accreditation rights
- Is compatible with a dynamic sector
- Reflective on the international development in (external) QA
- Supports the realization of NOKUTs strategy 2023-2030

ESG 2.2 as guiding principle:

“Designing methodologies fit-for purpose”

Stakeholder involvement in developing the next review cycle

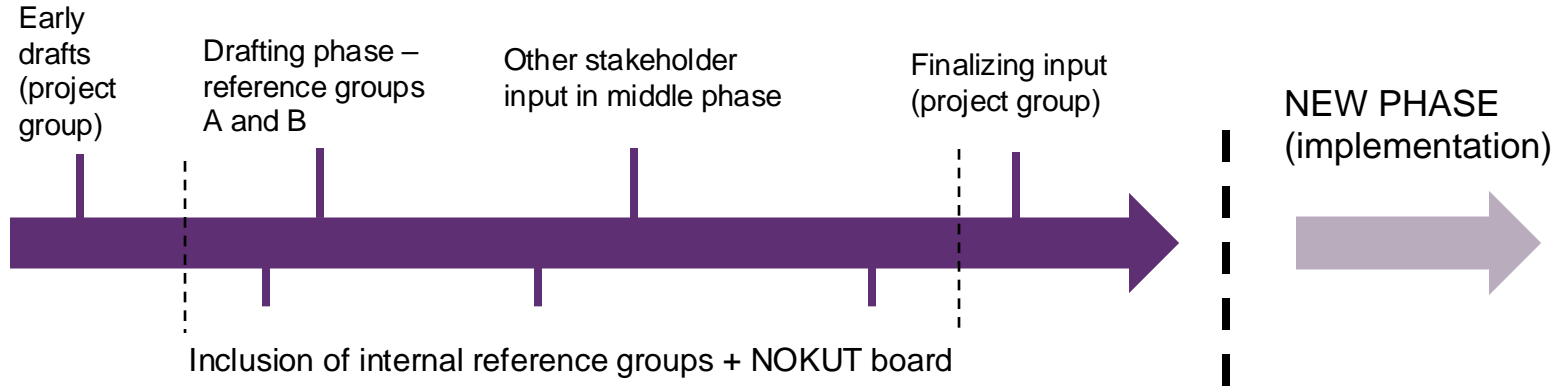
How are they involved?

- **Internal reference groups** read through drafts, gave written comments, in addition to regular meetings
- **Other external actors** give feedback in Q&A sessions
